



AUTHOR AGREEMENT

By signing this Agreement, you grant to the National Academy of Elder Law Attorneys (“NAELA”) an irrevocable, non-exclusive license to publish (and edit for publication) your article (the “Work”) in any format, presently known or unknown, including print and electronic, and including as part of the NAELA Online Article database and other collections, compilations, and collective works. This license includes the right to publish, reproduce, distribute, sublicense, sell, and create derivative works of the Work in NAELA’s discretion. However, you retain the right to copyright the Work on its own, and to publish or make whatever use you wish of the Work in your discretion.

You represent and warrant that:

- a) The Work is original, and you are the sole author;
- b) If the Work contains any material from other works protected by copyright, you have obtained the written consent of the copyright owner(s) and have provided (or are simultaneously providing) NAELA with copies of all such written consents;
- c) Except as provided in section (b), above, you are the sole owner of all rights in and to all portions of the Work;
- d) The Work has not been previously published, nor has it been submitted for publication;
- e) The Work does not violate or infringe on any personal or property rights of others, whether common law or statutory;
- f) The Work contains nothing defamatory or otherwise contrary to law;
- g) NAELA may include your name, likeness, contact information (including email), and biographical information in connection with publishing of the article, and may provide the same to those requesting authorization to reprint all or part of the article; and
- h) You have full authority to enter into this Agreement.

Finally, you acknowledge and agree that the decision to publish the Work shall be determined by NAELA in its sole judgment, and NAELA has no obligation to publish the Work.
